WHITNEY BENEFITS INC. HONORED AT OUR NATION'S CAPITAL FOR THEIR CONTINUED SUPPORT TO SHERIDAN COLLEGE

During the Council for Resource Development's (CRD) national conference held in Washington D.C. on November 2, 2007, Whitney Benefits, Inc. was awarded the 2007 Benefactor Award in honor of their contributions to Sheridan College.

The Council for Resource Development (CRD), representing over 1600 members at more than 700 two-year colleges, is an affiliate council of the American Association of Community Colleges. CRD supports professionals and develops leaders engaged in community college resource development through education, advocacy and mentoring.

Whitney Benefits, Inc. Vice President Roy Garber traveled to Washington DC and accepted the award on behalf of Whitney Benefits. During his acceptance speech, Garber explained "we are a large foundation in a relatively small community and as such it becomes difficult not to be swayed away from the wishes of our Founder." Garber went on to say, "I am proud of our board for staying true to Mr. Whitney's directions and have continued enhancing educational opportunities."
