

## **Sheridan College groundbreaking ceremony held on March 10, 2008**

Sheridan College hosted a ground breaking ceremony on March 10 on the north side of the Griffith Memorial Building to kick off the construction of Whitney Villas, a group of nine new buildings that will provide housing for students.

“This is an exciting time for Sheridan College,” Cheryl Heath, the Vice President for Administration and Chief Financial Officer at SC said. “We are adding 83 new beds on campus with these buildings.”

Though the buildings all vary in square footage, they are primarily designed as two story units with a residential look in style.

The Dayton-based Wright Brothers Building Company expects to have six of the nine stick-built units completed by September 1 when students are able to move into student housing. The remaining three units are expected to be completed by Sept. 30.

The majority of the funding for this project, \$7.4 million, was donated by Whitney Benefits. “Sheridan College thanks Whitney Benefits for their generous gift that allows us to move forward with this project,” Heath said.
